Valora and the Department of Justice

The U.S. Department of Justice has renewed its contract for automated document encoding and related services with Waltham, Mass.-based Valora Technologies Inc. (www.valoratech.com). Under the contract, Valora is obligated to turn around all projects received from the D.O.J. within two weeks with 98.5 percent accuracy or higher.

Valora is responsible for more than 17 million pages for the D.O.J.
